BOARDING and DEPARTURE

Boarding is generally one to three hours prior to departure. All times are subject to boat availability. Contact Horizon Charters for updated boarding times. Due to increased vessel security, passengers are required to show photo identification before boarding. Prior to departure the captain will conduct a detailed boat and safety orientation, everyone that will be joining the trip must be present

ACCOMMODATIONS

The bunks come with a pillow and blanket, and on multiday trips sheets are also provided. You may wish to bring a sleeping bag. 8 small cabins along with additional dormitory style bunks define the accommodations. All bunks have reading lights and the dormitory bunks have privacy curtains. The berthing areas are compact, please pack accordingly. Soft luggage is recommended.

RESTROOMS and CLOTHES DRYER

There are two restrooms onboard and two indoor hot water showers. There is also one hot freshwater shower on the dive deck. You will have a clothes dryer at your disposal for towels, bathing suits, lycras,

FOOD and DRINK

The boat has a full galley with scrumptious home cooked meals that are varied and appeal to today's lighter tastes. ALL meals, snacks, fruit, soda, water, coffee and tea are included in the trip fee. Alcoholic beverages and specialty drinks (announced by the cook.) are available for a nominal fee and are paid for at the end of the trip. In addition, for your safety, the sale of alcoholic beverages is regulated. Your first alcoholic beverage of the day comes after your last dive of the day.

ICE CHESTS & COOLERS

Ice chests or coolers are not permitted onboard due to space limitations. If you need to bring specialized food or drink please contact us. We may be able to make space for your items in our refrigerators or freezers or could purchase the item for you in advance and have it onboard when you arrive.

FRESHWATER

Both boats have twin desalinators with the ability to make up to 1500 gallons of freshwater per day.

SATELLITE TELEPHONE I E-MAIL SERVICE

Because we understand how important it is for you to be in touch with the main land, Horizon Charters has a satellite telephone for your use. The fee is \$3.00 per minute. E-mail is available at \$3.00 per sent mail. The fee covers any incoming mail you may receive. PHOTOS MAY NOT BE SENT OR RECEIVED.

AIR FILLS

The boats are equipped with two high-pressure compressors with air fills available to 3,500 p.s.i. There is never an air charge on any Horizon Charters trip. NITROX is available on Horizon only. More information in the NITROX section.

TANKS and WEIGHT BELTS

For your convenience, Horizon Charters provides tanks (aluminum 80's), weights and weight belts on all trips. You may bring your personal tank if it has a current hydrostatic test and visual inspection. If either of those prerequisites are not met, we will not fill your tank. Hydrostatic tests must be performed every 5 years while visual inspections are required annually. QNL Y ONE PERSONAL TANK PER PERSON WILL BE ALLOWED ON BOARD.

CALIFORNIA HUNTING

You MUST have a valid California fishing license onboard the boat if you wish to take game in California waters. All Department of Fish and Game regulations will be enforced. HORIZON CHARTERS ENCOURAGES STRICT CONSERVATION PRACTICES. Take only what you will use. Do not waste the oceans precious resources. Lobster may be taken in season. Abalone may not be taken. Spearfishing while on SCUBA is allowed at all of our United States dive destinations but not on our Baja, Mexico trips. Spearfishing while free diving is allowed at all of our destinations. Live and refrigerated game storage is provided, with game cleaning available upon request.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Horizon Charters is pleased to accommodate your sophisticated (and expensive) equipment. There are fresh water rinse buckets, camera storage areas in the main salon and on the dive deck along with electrical outlets for recharging batteries. Television plug-ins are available for showing off your video efforts at days end.

DIVE SAFETY

Certified dive masters trained in CPR, first aid and oxygen administration will be onboard to oversee your dive safety. The boat is equipped with first aid, oxygen, inflatable chase boats and a diver recall system.

GRATUITY

Gratuity is not included in the charter fee, however, is customary when you feel the exceptional. A 10- 15% gratuity is appropriate and very much appreciated by the crew.

PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION AND BAGGAGE SEARCH

Due to improved port security measures, Horizon Charters is now required to verify picture identification for all passengers. Depending on the current security threat level, Horizon Charters maintains the right to search all baggage prior to boarding and while underway.

PASSENGER ROSTER

Three days prior to departure, Horizon Charters will require a faxed or e-mail up to date list of all verified passengers along with a completed bunk assignment chart. Before boarding the vessel, passenger identification will be verified against the roster provided. Any person that fails to produce photo identification and / or are not listed on the passenger roster will be denied access to the vessel.

ZERO TOLERANCE DRUG ENFORCEMENT:

Detection, usage or possession of narcotics, including marijuana, by any member of the charter party will result in the termination of the charter and forfeiture of all funds. The proper authorities will be notified.

FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES:

All firearms and explosives of any kind are strictly forbidden onboard Horizon Charters Vessels. Detection of such will result in the termination of the charter and forfeiture of all funds.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND COOLERS

No alcoholic beverages or coolers with food are to be brought aboard.

LIABILITY WAIVERS AND PASSENGER INFORMATION QUESTIONNAIRES

Liability Waivers and Passenger Information Questionnaires must be filled out, signed and returned for each passenger no later than 15 days prior to sail. For passengers that join the charter within the 15 days prior to departure Liability Waivers and Passenger Information Questionnaires must be completed and given to a Horizon Charters representative prior to boarding.

SURCHARGES

A fuel surcharge will be added if fuel costs rise substantially. Also, if additional permits or licenses are required by the United States or Mexican government the cost will be passed on to the chartering group or individual. You will be notified if this becomes necessary.

Driving Directions

The boats are located in San Diego Bay, just minutes from San Diego International Airport. If coming by car, take 1-5 South or 1-8 West to the Rosecrans exit. Follow Rosecrans 3.5 miles to Jack in the Box at Emerson Street and turn left. Go 1.5 blocks and Emerson dead ends right into the bay. The H&M Landing office will be on your left.

If you are coming north on 1-5 take the Hawthorn Street exit to Harbor Drive and turn right. Follow Harbor to Scott Street. Turn left and follow Scott to Emerson.

Be sure to give yourself plenty of time to park. The parking lot fee is \$5.00 for every 24 hours. If the lot is full you may park on the street or the parking overflow parking lot on Harbor Drive. The lot on Harbor is also \$5.00 per 24 hours.

We suggest that you unload your gear and bring it to the boat, then look for parking. Please DO NOT leave anything unattended.
